

In January of 1988, I was raped by Detective Robert German and Lieutenant Robert Holiday of the Benton Police Department during which a dog was used and pictures were taken.

I believe they did this sickening and humiliating act to keep me quiet about several drug transactions and what I believed to be a drug pay-off I had witnessed between Teddy Carter and Detective Robert German.

After this incident, Detective German forced me to become involved in perverted sex acts using pictures from the first rape and threats of harm to my family and myself as intimidation.

The acts that I was forced to do were against my will and, in my eyes, rape.

On one of these occasions I was tied to a picnic table and gang-raped by approximately seven men. One of these men

I identified on Friday, September 16 as being Detective Kirk Lane of the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office.

Since the time that I reported the incident that happened to me to the FBI, I have been followed, harassed, and intimidated by people I believe are involved in this.

On March 25, 1988, the FBI went so far as to give Teddye Carter and I five hundred dollars to leave Little Rock because they had become aware that Detective Kirk Lane and Detective Robert German had been inquiring as to our whereabouts. The FBI felt that they were going to do us harm.

In early August of this year, a brick was thrown through the window of my 1984 Camaro and four days later the Camaro and two other cars in my yard were burned. These incidents happened the week before I was

to talk to Richard Garrett, the deputy prosecuting attorney in Benton about my allegations.

All the incidents that I've described above have been reported to the FBI, the Little Rock Police Department, the Saline County Prosecuting Attorney's office, and are currently being investigated by the Arkansas State Police.
