## INTERVIEW OF WITNESS

Mr. CROOK was interviewed by this investigator at the Garland County jail in 2-21-90 at 10:35 a.m. and he related that the morning the two boy's bodies were found at the railroad tracks that he and a friend were at his club when a Mexican looking guy, who he only knows as JERRY, came by and told them that late last night he was sitting across from the Ranchette Grocery Store in Alexander trying to catch his wife with her boyfriend, when two boys walked up to the grocery store and one boy rode up on a motorcycle and the three of them were there smoking a joint.

CROOK states that the boy of the motorcycle rode off and after he rode off, an unmarked policies car pulled up and two men in plain clothes got out and JERRY said one of them was KIRK LANE, who used to work for the Benton Police Department, and the other guy he did not know but he was a large man. CROOK states that the boys and these two cops got into an argument and the two cops beat the boys unconscious and threw them into the car and then drove off.

CROOK states that he told this JERRY that he ought to go tell Sheriff STEED of the Saline County Sheriff's Office what he saw and later on JERRY told him that he told Sheriff STEED and STEED locked him up for late child support payments.

CROOK states that before KEITH MCKASKLE was killed, MCKASKLE told him that KIRK LANE and JAY CAMPBELL of the Pulaski County Sheriff's Office were following him around and he was afraid they were going to kill him.

CROOK also states that after MCKASKLE was killed, LANE and CAMPBELL

shot up his house one night. He states that his son was at the club and someone called and said MCKASKLE is dead and you are next and then later shots were fired into his house and when he looked out he saw the Camaro going down the road from his house that KIRK LANE drives. He states that he called the Little Rock Police Department but they

never did come out.
