What can you say about a man who got a speeding ticket at age seven? Or who had a run-in with the FBI at age eight? Or became a floor trader at sixteen?

Nicholas A. Guarino, editor of *The Wall Street Underground*, is simply the fastest and brightest mind we've ever worked with. As publishers of sophisticated financial information, we consider ourselves fairly intelligent, yet we find ourselves totally outclassed by Nick in most ways. (Exception: He can't spell for sour apples.)

(He was tall for his age.) When Nick was sixteen, his boss fell ill one day and had to leave in the midst of a trading crisis. Nick intuitively knew what trades had to be done, so he put on a trader's coat, marched out onto the floor, and started trading. "Made money, too," Nick says. (Yes, the other traders knew how old he was, but they all liked the spunky kid, so no one squealed!)

Even in his twenties, Nick was enormously successful on Wall Street. In fact, he was getting buyout offers from brokerage competitors who flat-out admitted, "Frankly, kid, you're making us look *terrible*."


But rather than retiring young, he dived into a lifelong, ferocious effort to correct the corrupt political and financial networks that had completely destroyed his late grandfather's fortune.

You and guys like us are the fathers of the new government. Hell, we're the new covenant.

An amazing statement, wasn't it? Especially for 1986.

Victims No. 10 & 111. Keyin Lyes and Don Henry, two Bryant, Arkansas, teenagers, apparently were a bit too snoopy about the air drops of dope and cash they had observed in the nearby countryside at night (part of the Mena operation).

They were found on the morning of August 23, 1987, having been run over by a train. "They fell asleep on the tracks," according to state medical examiner Fahmy Malak, a Clinton appointee who had earned the anger of the locals by pulling such

stunts before.

(Remember when Clinton's late mother, anesthesia nurse Virginia Kelley, caused the death of two patients by neglect? Malak was the one who cleared her. Malak once even declared that a decapitated

man had à "natural causes," a ruling Clinton defended as a mere symptom of overwork.)

Malak's opinion caused a big ruckus locally. Eventually, the boys' irate parents managed to get a second coroner's opinion, and the official causes of death were changed to being stabbed in the back and getting a crushed skull *before* the train came. At this point...

All were slain before their testimony could do any good. Police involvement is suspected in most

cases, but not all:

• Keith Coney had been slashed in the neck and was fleeing for his life when his motorcycle slammed into the back of a truck. "A traffic fatality," police said.

Gregory Collins was found shot in the face by

a shotgun.

• Keith McKaskle was brutally stabbed at home—113 times. (He knew he was doomed, and had told his friends and family goodbye.)

• The burned body of Jeff Rhodes was found in the city dump, shot in the head—and with his

hands, feet, and head partly cut off.

• Richard Winters was killed by a man with a

12-gauge sawed-off shotgun.

• Jordan Ketelson died of a shotgun blast to the head and was found in the driveway of a house in Garland County. "A suicide," the sheriff said.

Do you see a pattern here?

All in all, after ten years of Mena operations, not one arrest was ever made, an accomplishment that is possible only when someone controls the whole state like a collie controls sheep.

Victim No. 18. Danny Casolaro was a reporter who was investigating the connections between Mena, BCCI, Iran-Contra, Reagan's "October Surprise," Park-on-Meter Co. (which made dope-storage nose cones for the airplanes at Mena), and the ADFA (Clinton's billion-dollar state bonds racket). He affectionately called this network The Octopus. On August 10, 1991, just as he was about to receive information linking Iran-Contra to the Inslaw scandal, Danny was found with his wrists slit in the bathtub of a hotel room in West Virginia. What a coincidence. We all remember this incertainty

# Officials quiet on allegations Harmon beat ex-wife, threatened neighbor

BENTON — Officials continued to maintain their silence Tuesday about what, if anything, will be done about allegations that Prosecuting Attorney Dan Harmon beat his exwife, and threatened her and a neighbor.

neighbor.
Police presented the case to City Attorney Sam Ed Glbson on Feb. 22 and asked him to review the files to determine if charges

might be warranted.

Police Chief Rick Elmendorf, who was out of his office Tuesday, said last week that he would have no further comment.

He said any statement about

the case would have to come from Gibson.

Gibson did not return telephone messages left this past week at his office, and a receptionist said he did not wish to talk to a reporter who stopped by the office Tuesday.

Mayor Mitch McDonald said

Mayor Mitch McDonald said Tuesday that any action "will be up to the city attorney."

Teresa Huchingson, 31, told police that Harmon, 50, came to her house Jan. 29. She told an officer that he struck and kicked her, and threatened to kill her if she reported the attack

A neighbor, Laquada Turner, 36, told police that she walked in on the assault and Harmon

also threatened her.

Police did not arrest Harmon, who serves as prosecutor for Saline, Grant and Hot Spring counties.

Harmon has refused to comment to the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette, but told the Benton newspaper that he did not harm Huchingson.

The alleged attack on Huchingson followed several similar incidents reported late last

year by Harmon's current wife, Holly Harmon, 26.

After one reported assault in December, police observed bruises and red marks on Holly Harmon's neck and a bump on her head.

An officer reported that Harmon also admitted putting a gun to Holly Harmon's head and

grabbing her.

Ironically, officers arrested a 22-year-old Benton man and jailed him on suspicion of third-degree battery in a domestic-abuse case the day before Gibson received the Huchingson case.

An officer who arrested the 22-year-old said that the man's wife had a puffy eye, and bruises on her lip and on a foot and toes.

Police have authority to make an arrest if they observe evidence such as injuries in a

domestic-abuse case, but Elmendorf said his department did not seek charges against Harmon after the alleged December assault because Holly Harmon did not want to pursue the matter.

Huchingson and Turner have said they want to seek charges against Harmon but have changed their minds, saying they fear what Harmon might do to them. (Indicate page, name of newspaper, city and state.)

DAN HARMON, a local attorney, and RICHARD GARR' deputy prosecuting attorney for Saline County, approached victims' parents regarding their discontent with the ruli HARMON offered to act as counsel for the families. Shortly thereafter, DAN HARMON was appointed the "special prosecutor in the case by Saline County, Arkansas, Judge JOHN COLE.

Little Rock FBI investigation reveals that Benton Chief of Police RICK ELMENDORF, Judge JOHN COLE, and DAN HARMON were at Judge COLE's residence when DAN HARMON suggested that he be made special prosecutor for the IVES-HENRY case.

Since the beginning of the investigation by the "special prosecutor," the case has become riddled with rumors and innuendos. Special Prosecutor HARMON and assistant, RICHARD GARRETT, requested assistance from the Arkansas State Police, yet continuously withheld information from them. A gag order was placed on the case, yet Little Rock FBI investigation reveals that the gag order was violated by DAN HARMON who would release information to the press on a regular basis.

Since the beginning of the FBI investigation,
December 1993, numerous individuals interviewed have provided
information alleging the involvement of and
in drug
trafficking as well as involvement in the deaths of captioned
victims.

Deputy Prosecuting Attorney RICHARD GARRETT appeared on an airing of "Unsolved Mysteries" requesting that individuals with "tips" on captioned victims' deaths call in information. RICHARD GARRETT went on to say that it was believed that the victims discovered a methamphetamine lab and one of them was accidentally killed and something had to be done with the other one.

Due to the extreme interest in this case by the United States Attorney's Office, the Little Rock FBI would appreciate these leads being handled as expeditiously as possible.




